Moodle self-assessment-tests of entry level in MSE theory modules

The Moodle self-assessment course is for you as (future) MSE student, wanting to check if you fulfil the prerequisites for specific theory modules in the MSE. The tests provide information on how to close knowledge-gaps before starting the module.

Use of Moodle self-assessment-tests

- Offer: Chosen MSE theory modules offer a self-assessment-test in form of Moodle quizzes.
- Purpose: The required entry-level competencies of each theory module are defined in the respective module description (msengineering.ch). With the self-assessment-tests, you can identify knowledge gaps and find information on how to close these knowledge gaps before choosing or attending the module.
- Technicalities: Detailed information on each test are in the course.
 - Read the hints for preparation before starting the test.
 - Please note, in order to save the results, export them immediately after finishing the test. Your test results are visible to the lecturers who have built the test.
